RTX 2012 Virtual Network Add-on

Release Date

A Virtual Network Add-on for RTX 2012 will be released on August 24, 2012.

Product Overview

IntervalZero announces a Virtual Network Add-on to the latest version of our market-leading hard real-time RTX software, which transforms Windows into a real-time operating system (RTOS).

The RTX Virtual Network Add-on provides a point-to-point connection between Windows and RTX that emulates a local area network connection on a system. The network consists of a Windows Virtual RTX Ethernet Adapter and an RTX Virtual NIC which is used by the RT-TCP/IP Stack. No Network Interface Cards (NICs) are required.

The RTX Virtual Network Add-on is supported for RTX 2012 only and is not applicable to earlier versions of the RTX product.

Features and Benefits

RTX Virtual Network Add-on:

- Provides a point-to-point connection that emulates a socket connection between RTX and Windows applications on a single system
- Does not require any additional physical hardware; no RTX-supported NIC is needed
- Provides the flexibility to move applications that use socket communication running on multiple systems to one system with no code changes
