Resolved Issues

RTX 2012 with Update 4 includes the following updates:

Subsystem

 Resolves an issue regarding the subsystem not handling an exception when there was a failure to acquire memory from Windows during object creation. (2114)

RT-TCP/IP Stack and Drivers

- Resolves an issue regarding the enumeration logic in the RT-TCP/IP Stack which caused
 the stack to not recognize some installed Network Interface Cards (NICs). This issue
 appeared when NICs were installed in PCI locations that had a non-sequential PCI
 function number. (2116)
- Resolves issues with performance of the RtIGB Real-time Network driver. (2125, 2127)

Samples

Resolves an issue regarding the PCI Scanbus sample not properly enumerating devices.
 This issue appeared when devices were installed in PCI locations that had a non-sequential PCI function number. (2117)
